

Riverlife Mirrabooka – Aboriginal Cultural Experience

Meet the local Brisbane Aboriginal Tribe Riverlife Mirrabooka and share in rich Aboriginal culture presented by the Yuggera Aboriginal Dancers in the natural bushland of Kangaroo Point.

Develop an awareness of the diverse aspects of contemporary Aboriginal culture by witnessing and participating in traditional song and dance passed down over many generations, primitive fire starting techniques, playing of Aboriginal musical instruments (such as didgeridoos) and listening to Indigenous educational talks that offer an insight into Aboriginal life and history of this ancient land. Other traditional activities such as boomerang throwing, message stick painting, face painting, clap stick painting and traditional food tasting may be included in the Aboriginal experience.

Riverlife Mirrabooka also performs authentic 'Welcome to Country' ceremonies and promotes an awareness of Indigenous culture, history and traditions to schools and excursions, universities, media, international and domestic visitors and Brisbane residents. Since the group's formation twelve years ago, the Yuggera Aboriginal Dancers have performed to audiences in Australia and throughout the world. Already popular with travellers from the UK and Europe, their audience members range from Queen Elizabeth II to the street children of Asia.

Riverlife Mirrabooka offers a rare opportunity to share in rich Aboriginal spiritual connections to our country in the heart of Brisbane. An opportunity not to be missed!
